INVER GROVE HEIGHTS, MN – Cable subscribers metro-wide will have the opportunity to have their tax questions answered by a panel of experts on Call-n-Talk Taxes. The popular LIVE call-in show can be seen on Thursdays, March 5<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> from 7 until 8:30 PM on both Community Channel 14 in the Northern Dakota County area, and on Metro Channel 6 all across the Twin Cities region. Both shows will also be streamed Live and On-Demand on the web at [www.townsquare.tv](http://www.townsquare.tv). Jeff Lockhart will host the show and Richard “Tiger” Schmitt, a CPA; Paul Hassing, a Certified Financial Planner; Theresa Gust from the Minnesota Department of Revenue; and Carrie Resch from the IRS will be on hand to answer questions from viewers.
