PRIMARY ELECTION RESULTS ON COMMUNITY CHANNEL 14

INVER GROVE HEIGHTS, MN – The Northern Dakota County Cable Communications Commission (NDC4) will be posting local primary election results on Community Channel 14 on Tuesday, September 9th. Result postings will begin at 8:00 PM when the polls close on Primary Election night, and run during the day on Wednesday, September 10. Primary Election results will also be posted on the web at www.townsquare.tv. Cable subscribers and internet users in Northern Dakota County will see results of Primary Elections for United States Senator, Minnesota Supreme Court, and Mayor and City Council races for the cities of Inver Grove Heights, South St. Paul, and West St. Paul. Primary Election result postings are produced jointly through NDC4 and Town Square Television.

The Northern Dakota county Cable Communications Commission (NDC4) is a joint powers cooperative formed by the cities of Inver Grove Heights, Lilydale, Mendota, Mendota Heights, South St. Paul, Sunfish Lake, and West St. Paul to administer and enforce the cable television franchise ordinance for each of the seven cities. NDC4 is the local franchise authority representing cable subscribers' consumer interests, and also oversees seven local community channels on the Comcast cable system.

Town Square Television is a non-profit organization producing local television programs and providing access to video production equipment, training, and cable television channel time for community members who wish to televise their own programs. Town Square Television channels are 14, 15, 16, 18, 19, 20, and 21 and can be viewed by over 21,000 cable television households in its seven member cities.
